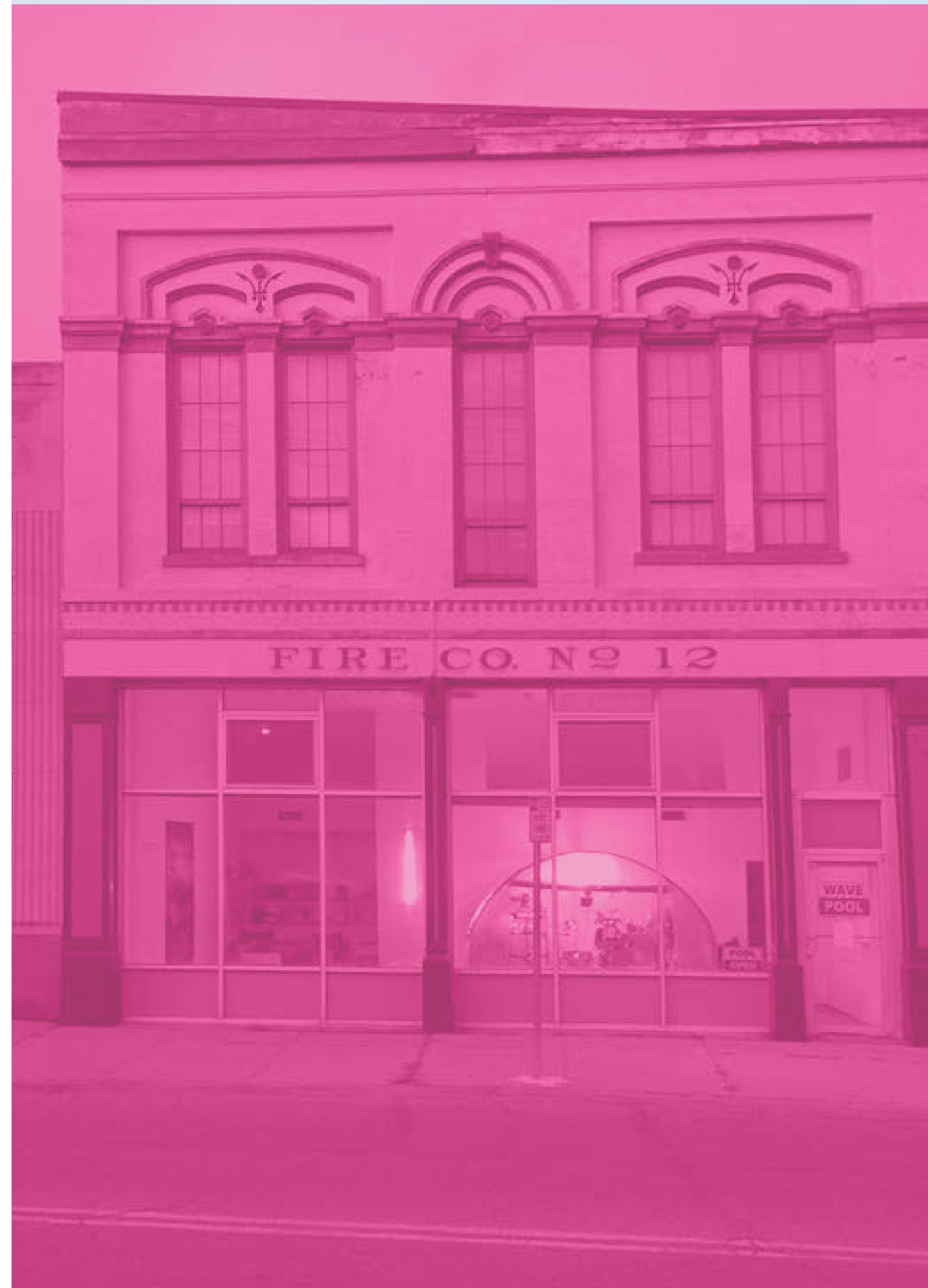


## WavePool Gallery

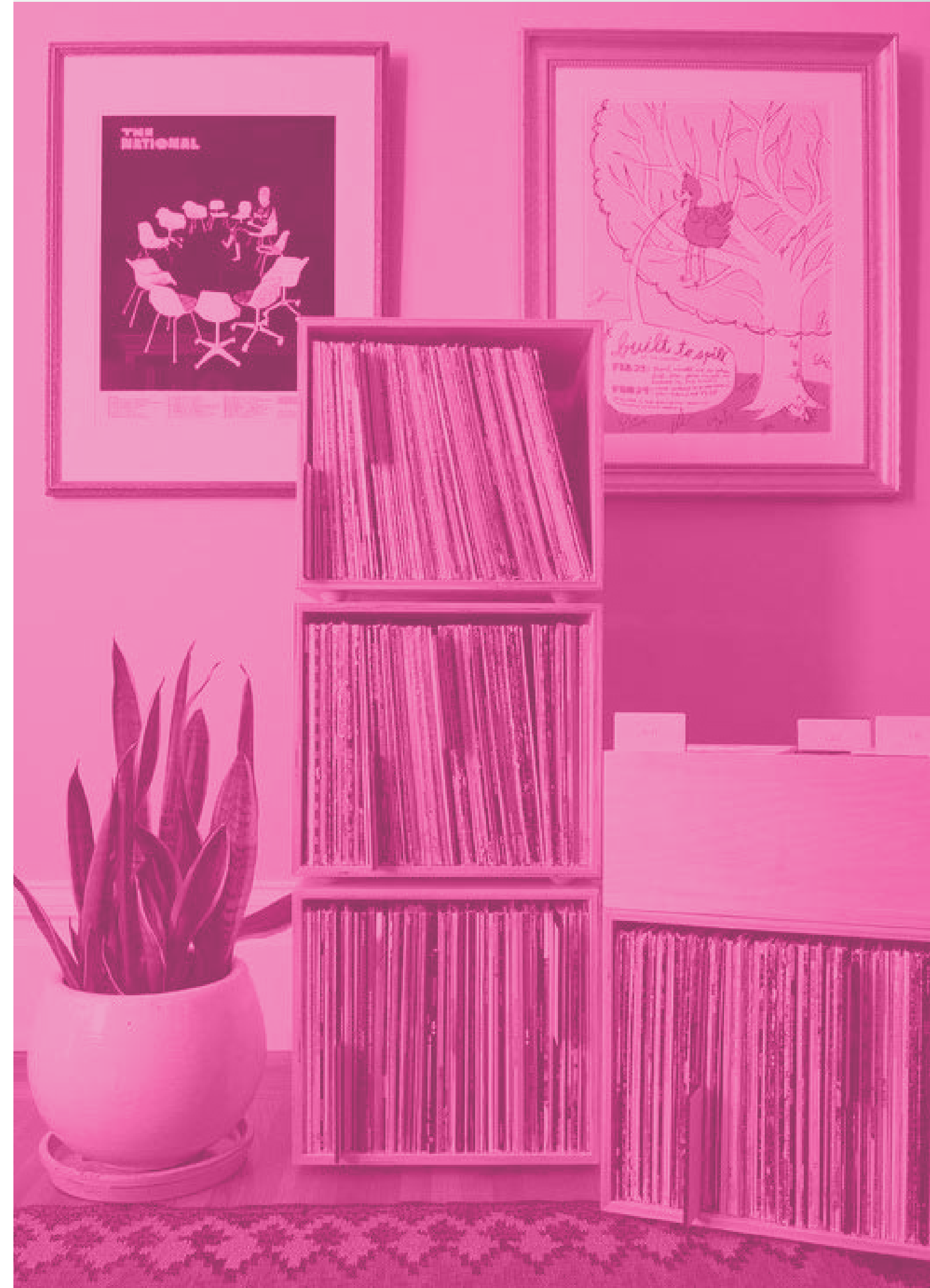


## Simple Wood Goods

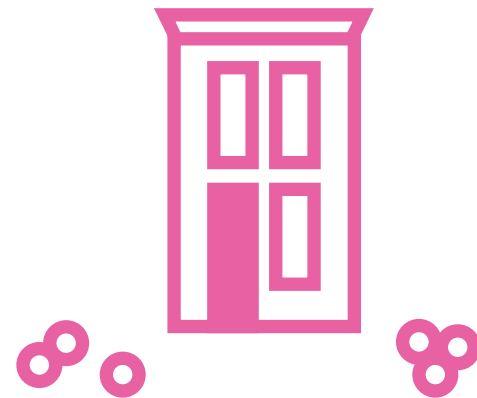
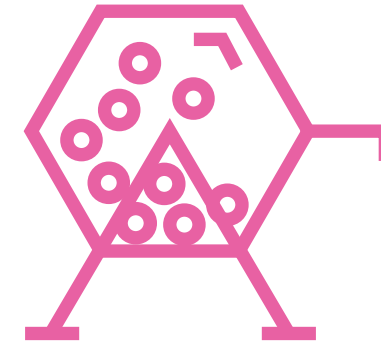
